

Riverside Homeowner's Association Email Policy

Pursuant to the Bylaws of the Riverside Homeowner's Association (RHOA), approved 2/17/2013, resident homeowners must be paid (current) and registered to be considered members of the RHOA. We will maintain active email addresses for all paid (current) and registered members of the RHOA. This will constitute our database. Residents within the RHOA boundaries whose dues are unpaid or have expired will not be part of the database.

Emails from the RHOA will be distributed only to those names and addresses in the database. Should a member of the RHOA not have a functioning email address, we will attempt to deliver messaging via traditional mail or hand delivery as deemed appropriate by the RHOA Board of Directors.

It is the policy of the RHOA to limit emails to items that directly relate to the welfare and/or safety of our members, relate to issues affecting our neighborhood or fundraisers that somehow directly benefit our members or local area. The determination of what qualifies within the above categories, will be at the sole discretion of the RHOA Board of Directors.

The RHOA will not promote fundraisers from local schools, teams or clubs/scouts. For this purpose we have created open-source communication s channels via Facebook and Nextdoor Riverside.
